.... Our 2018 Financial Stewardship Campaign

As for the rich 1st Timothy 6:18-19 They are to do good, to be rich in good deeds, liberal and generous, thus laying up for themselves a good foundation for the future.

Stewardship is about recognizing that all we have belongs to God. Whatever we have during our lifetime is simply entrusted to us for the journey. Everything belongs to God.

The spiritual discipline of giving is an important discipleship practice, just like worship, prayer, and service. There are two important aspects of this discipline: take time to reflect on and appreciate how God has blessed you; determine how your household will regularly practice giving.

Having an emphasis on what it means to be a steward helps us to grow better stewards in our home, church, and community. Stewardship is not about paying the bills. It is about using the gifts God has entrusted to us, individually and collectively, to do God's work. An emphasis each year helps teach us about what it means to be stewards of God's varied grace.

An emphasis on stewardship provides an opportunity to reflect on the role of money in our lives. One of the ways people in a church can respond to this emphasis is by making a financial commitment. This is both an example of living out the spiritual discipline of giving and an opportunity to share in God's generosity. We can share a portion or percentage of what God has given us with others in and through our church. For many households this means taking time to make a budget and to be intentional about where and how the dollars entrusted to them are used. The skill of budgeting teaches us how to make commitments with our money and to be held accountable. These traits transfer easily to other aspects of our life, including how we are generous with time and talents.
